What is Battlefield Acupuncture (BFA)?

This ear (auricular) acupuncture protocol was developed by Dr Richard C. Niemtzow in 2001. He is a retired Air Force colonel and was the first full-time physician acupuncturist in the Armed Forces.

He originally conceived this technique as a way to deliver pain relief through acupuncture as quickly and efficiently as possible in combat and other military situations. It is growing in popularity in both military and civilian medical settings internationally.

This unique technique uses semi-permanent ASP® needles to activate ear points in order to influence the processing of pain in the central nervous system. According to Dr Niemtzow, pain relief can be immediate and hold for a longer stimulation. It can also be used in case of anxiety and insomnia.

Benefits for the military:

- The ear is always available
 - The soldiers can stay in uniform
- Very fast technique (a few minutes is enough), easy to learn, which can be practiced standing, which requires little equipment
 - Possibility of training the soldiers so that they apply them on each other when they are in operation
- Immediate action, without side effects
 - The soldier can continue his activities
- Reduction in opioid consumption
 - Avoid the risk of addictions and side effects

Recognized by NATO

In the report of the NATO HFM 195 Task Force on the Use of Integrative Medicine Interventions for Military Personnel, published in 2015, it is stated:

"Several modalities can be implemented into the military systems, with evidence that the treatments are safe, cost-effective, and efficacious for the military population. These include acupuncture, particularly battlefield acupuncture..."

This report recommends the implementation of multinational Battlefield Acupuncture programs.

BFA was recognized in 2019 as a solution to fight the opioid crisis by the Association of American Medical Colleges.

BFA was also presented in the documentary Escape Fire: The Fight to Rescue American Healthcare in 2012. In the excerpt here, you can see the insertion of ASP® needles at 4.26.

Auriculotherapy



Dr Paul Nogier (1908-1996), a neurophysiologist fascinated by acupuncture, homeopathy and psychology, demonstrated in the beginnings of the 1950s, that certain points on the external ear corresponded to organs or systems and that their distribution corresponded to the image of an **inverted fetus**.

This somatotopy, which defines the links between the pinna of the ear and the central nervous system via the brain stem, **recognized by the WHO since 1987**, is the basis for the practice of Auriculotherapy.

ASP® semi-permanent needle

The ASP® Original or Sedatelec Semi-Permanent Needle was created in France in collaboration with Dr Paul Nogier. It has been used on a daily basis by many practitioners, hospitals and pain centers throughout the world for over 40 years.

This sterile device is comprised of a small needle placed in a plastic injector. This injector makes it easy for the practitioner to hold and precisely implant the needle in the ear while ensuring it remains sterile. The needle can stay in place up to a maximum of 30 days for a prolonged stimulation of the auricular point.
