What is an Illusion?

An Illusion is something that is likely to be wrongly interpreted by the senses. It's deceptive in its appearance. If it fools our consciousness for a prolonged time this can lead us to having false ideas or beliefs.

What is a Perception?

It's a way of regarding, understanding, or interpreting something; a mental impression. An impression is an effect, feeling, or image retained because of experience produced in the mind.

Pocahontas's Christian name was Rebecca. This may have been a symbolic gesture to Rebecca of the Book of Genesis who, as the mother of Jacob and Esau, was the mother of two "nations", or distinct peoples. Pocahontas, as a Powhatan marrying an Englishman, may have been seen by herself and by her contemporaries as being also, potentially, a matriarchal figure of two distinct peoples.
